



Highlights for May 2018



1. There were **three (3)** bulk trash violation notices issued to residents for heavy trash at the curb.
2. Code Enforcement removed **23** signs from poles, **22** from right of ways; total signs removed for the year is **282**
3. There were **21** abandoned vehicles in the residential area, **six (6)** in the business area and **two (2)** in the Apartment areas: **two (2)** were impounded
4. For the first five months of 2018 we have had a total of **148** abandoned vehicles in town, **Nine (9)** of those were impounded!
5. Grass violation notices Issued - **27**
