Highlights for January 2019



1. There were **nine (9)** bulk trash violation notices issued to residents for heavy trash at the curb.
2. Code Enforcement removed **-29** signs from poles, **16** from right of ways; total signs removed for the year is **45**.
3. There were **39** abandoned vehicles in the residential area, **16** in the business area and **12** in the Apartment areas: **eight (8)** were impounded.
4. There were no grass violation notices issued.
5. Code Enforcement received **two (2)** Graffiti complaints.

Other Code Enforcement Activities:

- We assisted a resident who had tree fall from her neighbor's yard. We spoke with owner of the tree and he had a contractor remove the tree.
- The Code office was closed on Martin Luther King Day.
- Several Snow and Ice violation notices were issued to residents and business.
- We issued a building permit to Comcast to update the Fiber line on 57th Avenue.
- We assisted the Police Department with traffic control on Baltimore Avenue due to a dump truck knocking down two telephone poles and electrical wires.
