January 2019 Public Works Activities

During the month of January, Public Works worked on the following activities:

1. Removed all Christmas Decorations from Town Hall and Gazebo.
2. Public Works installed a new Pet Waste station in the 6000 block of Emerson St.
3. Removed old broken No Parking signs along Quincy St.
4. During the month of January Public Works was called out 5 time to salt / plow streets.
5. An aging tree was cut up and removed in the 5500 block of Tilden Road due to safety issues.
6. Public Works replaced flush valve in the Code/ Police Annex building.
7. Set up Town Hall council chambers for several meetings.
8. Installed two new spinner motors on the tailgate salt spreaders at Public Works.
9. Repaired the faucet in the Police Station due to slow draining.
