Highlights for February 2019



1. There were **eight (8)** bulk trash violation notices issued to residents for heavy trash at the curb.
2. Code Enforcement removed **-13** signs from poles, **8** from right of ways; total signs removed year to date is **66**.
3. There were **21** abandoned vehicles in the residential area, **14** in the business area and **12** in the Apartment areas: **six (6)** were impounded. Year to date we have had **59** abandoned vehicles and **19** have been impounded.
4. There were no grass violation notices issued.
5. Code Enforcement received **three (3)** Graffiti complaints.

Other Code Enforcement Activities:

- We assisted Public Works with Snow removal operations during several storms.
- The Code office was closed on Presidents Day.
- Issued new business license to Demat Global Concepts (Tag and Title) 5458 Annapolis Road.
- Issued Stop Work order to 5214 Tilden Road for building without permits.
- We assisted with traffic control due to a large water main Break on Annapolis Road.
- Responded to a call Alt. Route 1 for downed tree blocking the travel lanes that had fallen due to high winds.
