February 2019 Public Works Activities

During the month of February, Public Works worked on the following activities:

1. Public Works removed all overgrown vegetation located near sidewalks in the 6000 block of Emerson Street.
2. Due to heavy litter in the 6000 block of Emerson Street, Public works installed a new trash can along the sidewalk to encourage residents to place their trash in the receptacle and not discard litter on the ground
3. Removed the rest of the carpet in the Town Administrator office, also installed new stairs.
4. On the 20th of February Public Works made sure all streets in the Town were passable for residents during and after the snow storm.
5. Due to freezing temperatures there was a water main break in the 4600 block of Annapolis Road. Public Works was called out to transport safety barrels to the location.
6. Public Works assisted Ms. Diane and Ms. Diamond with transporting items for the Black History month event held at the Bladensburg Community center.
7. Minor (14' X 25') section of roadway was repaired in the 5700 block of Emerson Street.
8. Public Works delivered trash cans to new residents who recently moved into a house in the 5500 block of Blue Heron Way.
9. Due to the rain and snow pot holes have formed in the roadway. Public Works has identified the areas where pot holes needed to be filled to ensure the safety of Town residents, and has addressed each of the areas.
10. Repaired the stop sign in the 5300 block of Tilden Road struck by a vehicle.
11. Mr. Hall has been working with the Hyattsville superintendent to put a Stormwater Pollution Prevention plan in place for the Public Works building.
12. Public Works cut up and removed blown down tree limbs in the roadway going south bound on Route 1.
13. Installed 25mph school zone signs on 57th Avenue.
14. Due to all the rain Public works made sure all drain grates were clear of any debris.
15. Repaired the No Parking in the Alley sign located in the 4900 block of Taylor street.

Ground Maintenance:

1. Picked up litter in the following areas of Town:
 - a. Annapolis Road Pedestrian Tunnel
 - b. The Industrial Area
 - c. The alley-way in between 55th Ave and 56th Ave.
