April 2019 Public Works Activities:

During the month of April, Public Works worked on the following activities:

1. As part of a commitment during the summer time to help keep the Town clean, Public Works (Gabino Cardozo) assisted with several clean ups in the Town of Bladensburg in ward 2 along with Council Member Lundy and Mayor James and several volunteers.
