# Highlights for May 2019



1. There were **six (6)** bulk trash violation notices issued to residents for heavy trash at the curb.
2. Code Enforcement removed **-60** signs from poles, **25** from right of ways; total signs removed year –to- date is **275**.
3. There were **28** abandoned vehicles in the residential area, **18** in the business area, **five (5)** in the apartment areas and **four (4)** were impounded. Year –to- date we have had **236** abandoned vehicles and **34** have been impounded.
4. There were **38** grass violation notices issued.
5. Code Enforcement received **five (5)** Graffiti complaints.

## Other Code Enforcement Activities:

- On May 2<sup>nd</sup> The Code Department assisted the State Highway administration with traffic control on 48<sup>th</sup> Street while they cleaned the storm drains.
- On May 3<sup>rd</sup> The Code Department responded to Port Town Elementary School with Prince Georges County Animal Management to assist them relocate three (3) deer that were stuck in a fenced in area of the school. Two deer were able to be removed 1 deer had to be euthanized due to injuries.

- On May 6<sup>th</sup> the Code Department posted 5405 Upshur Street for Abatement due to high grass and trash on the property.
- On May 7<sup>th</sup> the Code Department posted 4205 Kenilworth Avenue for Abatement due to high grass and trash on the property.

- **On May 17<sup>th</sup> Code Enforcement Supervisor Rinehart assisted with the 2nd Annual Bike to Work event at Bladensburg Waterfront Park.**
- **On May 17<sup>th</sup> Code Enforcement Supervisor responded to Blue Heron Way to remove a 4foot Black snake from the roadway.**
