## June 2019 Public Works Activities:

During the month of June, Public Works worked on the following activities:

1. Due to a water leak in the 5300 block of Varnum Place, Public Works and Code Enforcement worked closely with WSSC to ensure the problem was resolved.
2. On the 13<sup>th</sup> of June Public Works was called out to the 4500 block of 57<sup>th</sup> Avenue due to a blown down tree limb blocking one lane of road. The Public Works crew cut up and removed the limb.
3. Due to the July 6<sup>th</sup> fireworks, event Public Works made sure the Pedestrian Tunnel was cleaned out.
4. We assisted Ms. Marilyn from the Emerson House with transporting chairs for their 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.
5. Public Works set up and worked the Summer Jam festival at the Cops office in Autumn Woods.
6. Public Works made sure all light items were moved out of all the administrated offices/ closets in the Town Hall to ensure the flooring company could install new vinyl flooring.
7. We assisted Code Enforcement with performing an abatement at 5424 Taussig Road, and 5037 60<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
9. Public Works delivered a trash can to a new resident who recently move into a house on the 4200 block of 56<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
10. We also finished repairing/ staining the rest of the stairs in the Town Administrator office.
11. The Public Works Crew Assisted Chief Stone with installing the July 6<sup>th</sup> fireworks banners at several locations throughout the Town of Bladensburg.
12. Due to several heavy down pours during the month of June Public Work took this time to install new ceiling tiles in the Town Hall.
